

Junior High School Semester Exam Exemption Policy
2020 - 2021

In response to COVID-19 and to accommodate for the virtual and traditional classroom, the junior high school exemption policy will be revised as follows for the 2020-2021 school year:

Junior High School students may qualify for an exemption in ANY course by receiving a 90 average or better.

Junior High students taking high school courses for high school credit at the junior high campus may qualify for an exemption in ANY course by receiving a 90 average or better.

Students must be present (according to student's current method of instruction) during semester exams, regardless of their exemption status. If a student is absent during a semester exam, the exemption will be waived and is no longer valid. If a student is absent during an exam, the teacher will enter an Incomplete or "I" for the student's final grade. The student will receive one opportunity to take a semester exam upon returning.

Qualification for exemption will be determined from current Skyward data.
